
Fragrant Freesia







Freesia sp.

- <u>Use:</u> Long-lasting clusters of blooms emit a seductive fragrance that easily perfumes an entire room. Deer resistant. Great cutflower.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- *Growth:* Grows 10-15" tall and 6-8" wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 9 to 10 (lift in fall in Zones 3-8 and store in a location above 45 degrees and below 60 degrees until after spring frosts have passed and temps above 20 degrees) Perennial. Bulb.
- Foliage: Deciduous. Strap shaped leaves.
- **Flower:** This colorful mix is perfect in a fresh summer bouquet. Blooms of white, yellow, red, pink or purple! Ideal for sunny borders or containers. The cooler the temperature, the longer the flowers will last.
