

# Costa Blanca Amaryllis

## *Hippeastrum 'Costa Blanca'*

- **Use:** This easy-to-grow bulb is a real gem! Plant 8-10 weeks before Christmas to enjoy flowers for the holidays! Amaryllis are perennials here in Georgia and come back every year with more and larger flowers each summer! Our premium Dutch bulbs are selected for their size, beauty, and reliability. Each bulb averages 2 stems and a total of 8 flowers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry, but allow soil to dry slightly in between watering. We don't recommend forcing them in straight water. Drought tolerant when established. Plant outdoors in late April in sandy soil and they will come back each year in zone 8.
- **Growth:** The elegant stems spread 1-2' tall each season. Height varies based on watering and light received.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-10; Perennial Herbaceous. After blooming is finished wait until after last frost in spring and then plant outdoors. They will then re-bloom each year in summer in your garden.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long, strap-like leaves.
- **Flower:** Strikingly beautiful, huge white blooms with green centers 8-10 weeks after planting. A pure pick-me up in the winter months exuding purity and grace.
