Hippeastrum 'Ferrari'

- <u>Use:</u> The shapely blooms and rich, iridescent colors of Amaryllis light up a cold day like nothing else we know. Brighten the short winter days with Amaryllis indoors for the holidays.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant when established, but prefers moist soil, but must be well-drained.
- Growth: The strong stems spread out to 12-18" tall and 6-8" wide. May grow taller if given too much water or not enough light.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 7-10; Perennial; Herbaceous. (it is claimed that they are cold hardy down to zone 6) In zones 7 and below, we recommend deep planting (up to 4 inches of soil above the bulb) and a thick winter mulch.
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. Long, strap-like leaves.
- <u>Flower:</u> This popular choice is shiny like a new Ferrari and equally attention-getting. Its flowers—strong, bold, and up to 4 per stem with 4 stems on this larger size —are a full 8" across. Allow 8–10 weeks from bulb to bloom.
