- <u>Use:</u> This easy-to-grow bulb is a real gem! Our bulbs are larger than most other stores which means more flowers! Amaryllis are perennials here in Georgia and come back every year with more and larger flowers each summer! Our premium Dutch bulbs are selected for their size (32/+cm), beauty and reliability. Each bulb will produce at least 2 stems and a total of 8 flowers.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry, but allow soil to dry slightly in between watering. We don't recommend forcing them in straight water. Drought tolerant when established. Plant outdoors in late April in sandy soil and they will come back each year in zone 8.
- <u>Growth:</u> Grows 12" tall. To keep short keep a little on the dry side and in full sun. After blooming is finished wait until after last frost in spring and then plant outdoors. They will then rebloom each year in summer.
- Hardiness: Zone 7-10 Perennial; Herbaceous.
- Foliage: Deciduous. Long, strap-like leaves.
- **Flower:** This sumptuous new variety is an unusual blend of orange, brick, salmon, peach and pink, depending on how the winter's light plays across it. It's perfectly formed flowers are etched with brick-red veins and topped off with a hazy chartreuse-green star at its center.
