

Hyacinth Apricot Passion



- **Planting density:** 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- **Planting depth:** 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.
- **Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.**

Hyacinthus 'Apricot Passion'

- **Use:** Beautiful colored blooms complimented by a sweetly smelling scent make hyacinths a favorite choice for many gardeners. Spectacular when planted alone but hyacinths also feature well when planted in flower beds containing tulips and daffodils. A rather strong naturalizing bulb and missing from the menu for deer and rodents, hyacinth bulbs are easy to grow and care for. Long-lasting cut flower. Hyacinths are great for indoor forcing, containers, and borders.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Grows 8-12” tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4 –8 Bulb
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Thick green leaves.
- **Flower:** A select hybrid in a new color—a light pastel apricot pink.
