

# Dwarf Blue Dutch Iris



## *Iris reticulata* 'Harmony'

- **Planting density:** 5 inch apart, 6-8 per sq. ft.
- **Planting depth:** 5 inches to base of the bulb.
- **Best planted in a mass for dramatic effect.**
- **Use:** Beds, rock gardens, in patio planters, and woodland gardens.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun (but must be 5-6 hours of sun) . Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Tolerates summer drought, but should be kept moist during growing season.
- **Growth:** Grows 5-6” tall.
- **Hardiness:** Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous.
- **Flower:** One of the first of the spring blooming bulbs in early March. Deep blue flowers with yellow, white rimmed blotch
