

Surprise/ Magic Lily



Lycoris squamigera 'Pink'

- Multiplies easily!
- Deer resistant
- Attracts hummingbirds
- Excellent in beds with shorter perennials or with groundcover plants. These long-lived plants deliver brilliance and fragrance for years. This is the most cold hardy of the lycoris family, and the only one with fragrance!
- **Use:** Pink Surprise Lily is as fun as it is lovely. Smooth grey-green foliage arrives in spring and dies back by summer. Then, later in the summer, almost as if by magic, slender stems arise bearing clusters of fragrant, delicate, star-shaped flowers. Once established, this hardy plant will return for many years to delight and surprise. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Remember too, that the red spider lily bulb performs well under trees that lose their leaves during winter, allowing the bulb's foliage to soak up sun energy. Grows in any soil, but prefers some good drainage.
- **Growth:** Grows 24-26" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-10 Perennial. Bulb.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Foliage stays green in winter through spring. Dormant leaves in summer.
- **Flower:** Flower stalks seem to appear overnight, bringing with them a lovely surprise to the late summer garden. The sweet fragrant pink trumpet-shaped blooms show up just when many other blossoms are fading for a late-season pop of fresh color.
