

Accent Daffodils



Narcissus 'Accent'

- **Planting density:** 6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- **Planting depth:** 6 inches to base of the bulb.
- **Best planted in a mass of 30 or more for dramatic effect.**
- **Use:** Award-winning Accent is a valuable sun-proof naturalizer with 4" flowers of ivory-white encircling a frilled funnel-shaped cup of light salmon-pink to salmon-rose. Beds, rock gardens, in patio planters, and woodland garden. We find it to truly be the easiest bulb to plant in the garden. Narcissus blooms are for many gardeners the first visible signs of spring. Deer Resistant. Good cut flower.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows 13" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8. Perennial. Bulb.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Do not cut off the leaves after flowering.
- **Flower:** Sun-proof, award-winner Narcissus 'Accent' is an elegant and prolific daffodil boasting star-shaped flowers, 4 in. across (10 cm), adorned with slightly reflexed, ivory-white petals and a contrasting, frilled funnel-shaped cup of deep salmon pink.
