Narcissus 'Fortune'

- **Use:** Beds, rock gardens, in patio planters, and woodland garden. We find it to truly be the easiest bulb to plant in the garden. Narcissus blooms are for many gardeners the first visible signs of spring. Deer Resistant. Good cut flower.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows 18-24" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8. Perennial. Bulb.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Do not cut off the leaves after flowering.
- **Flower:** Circa 1917, this award-winner is a long-lasting, vigorous grower with a well-overlapping, yellow perianth and a marigold-yellow crown, flushed red at the edges. A good forcer.



- **Planting density:** 6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- **Planting depth:** 8 inches to base of the bulb.
- **Best planted in a mass of 30 or more for dramatic effect.**
