Narcissus 'Geranium'

- **Use:** Sweetly fragrant with up to six 2" flowers per stem, this outward-facing, award-winning heirloom has a white perianth and a shallow bowl-shaped, bright yellowish-orange cup that is just slightly ribbed. Narcissus blooms are for many gardeners the first visible signs of spring. Deer Resistant. Good cut flower. Daffodils are the most cost effective, pest-free perennial plants available and make wonderful companions with other bulbs, perennials, annuals and flowering shrubs.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Drought tolerant once established. As with all Pink Narcissi, it benefits from filtered sunlight so that it may develop its best pink coloration.
- **Growth:** Grows to a height of 16" tall
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8. Perennial. Bulb.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Sturdy stems. Do not cut off the leaves after flowering. They will die back by summer end. It grows above its slender foliage, has a faint fragrance and is also good for warmer climates.
- **Flower:** The highly fragrant blooms of this heirloom spring treasure make it a must grow for flower arrangers and gardeners alike. Each stem is loaded with clusters of creamy white blooms that are accented by a glowing orange throat. Tazetta type.
