Narcissus 'Merel's Favorite'

- **Use:** Large, bright Narcissus blooms are for many gardeners the first visible signs of spring. These vigorous, long-lived bulbs thrive joyously in sunny, well-drained places, are shunned by hungry deer and voles, and will thrive and multiply with little care on your part, creating a glorious landscape and a horticultural legacy.
 - **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Drought tolerant once established. Will naturalize over time. Fertilize after bloom in spring for the largest spring blooms the following year.
 - **Growth:** Grows 14-16" tall.
 - **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9. Perennial. Bulb.
 - **Foliage:** Deciduous. Do not cut off the leaves after flowering. Requires minimum care. Allow the foliage to die back naturally. Lift dead foliage when it can be removed and these bulbs will return spring after spring.
 - **Flower:** The creamy white perianth of this sweetly scented Narcissus is crowned with a broad cup that opens a vivid shade of yellow. A bright contrast that carries over a long distance. Midseason.
- **Planting density:** 6 inch apart, 6 per sq. ft.
 - **Planting depth:** 8 inches to base of the bulb.
 - **Best planted in a mass of 30 or more for dramatic effect.**
