

# Obdam Daffodils



- Planting density: 6 inch apart, 6 per sq. ft.
- Planting depth: 8 inches to base of the bulb.
- Best planted in a mass of 30 or more for dramatic effect.



## *Narcissus 'Obdam'*

- **Use:** As it matures the Gardenia-like beauty's rich ivory multi-layered bloom will fill you with peace and tranquillity as you walk through your garden and take in the scent and serenity of this beautiful flower.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows 14-16" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9. Perennial. Bulb.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Do not cut off the leaves after flowering. Requires minimum care. Allow the foliage to die back naturally. Lift dead foliage when it can be removed and these bulbs will return spring after spring.
- **Flower:** A stunning pristine white daffodil with double peony-like flower heads. Late season.
