

Red Devon Daffodils



Narcissus 'Red Devon'

- **Planting density:** 6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- **Planting depth:** 6 inches to base of the bulb.
- **Best planted in a mass of 30 or more for dramatic effect.**
- **Use:** Those bold orange ruffling cups at the center of Red Devon's large 4" blooms are a knockout in the garden. It's no wonder this daffodil has won so many awards. They make a splash in borders, containers, or even just naturalized over an area you'd prefer not to drag the mower around, like a hillside. Like all daffodils, deer tend not to bother with Red Devon. Good cut flower.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows 18-20" tall and 12-14" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8. Perennial. Bulb.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Do not cut off the leaves after flowering.
- **Flower:** Large, 4" blooms of rich golden-yellow with large, vivacious red-orange cups look stunning in groups or alone. Fragrant daffodils are stunning along walkways or in bouquets. Large-Cupped
