

Silver Smiles Daffodils



Narcissus 'Silver Smiles'

- **Planting density:** 6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- **Planting depth:** 8 inches to base of the bulb.
- **Best planted in a mass of 30 or more for dramatic effect.**
- **Use:** A sweetly-scented daffodil with two or more flowers on every stem. The blossoms have thick, pure white petals and ruffled, pale yellow cups that gradually fade to white. Heat tolerant, long-lasting flowers are excellent for cutting. Beds, rock gardens, in patio planters, and woodland garden. It was selected for its distinctive color and the speed and ease with which it grows and multiplies. We find it to truly be the easiest bulb to plant in the garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows 14-16" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9. Perennial. Bulb.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Do not cut off the leaves after flowering.
- **Flower:** This fragrant cross of N. Olivet and N. jonquilla yields up to 3 flowers per stem and opens with a perfectly formed, glistening greenish-white perianth and a bright lemon-yellow cup that matures to buff-champagne, and then, to white. Blooms midseason.
