

White Lion Daffodils



Narcissus 'White Lion'

- **Planting density:** 6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- **Planting depth:** 8 inches to base of the bulb.
- **Best planted in a mass of 30 or more for dramatic effect.**



- **Use:** Beds, rock gardens, in patio planters, and woodland garden. We find it to truly be the easiest bulb to plant in the garden. Narcissus blooms are for many gardeners the first visible signs of spring. Deer Resistant. Good cut flower.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows 14-16" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8. Perennial. Bulb.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Do not cut off the leaves after flowering.
- **Flower:** A big award-winner since its 1940s' introduction, this 3 1/2" gardenia-like, fragrant naturalizer opens pale yellow and matures to creamy-white blooms dotted with shorter, yellow petal segments at its frilled, double center.
