

White Petticoat Daffodils



Narcissus bulbocodium 'White Petticoat'

- **Planting density:** 6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- **Planting depth:** 8 inches to base of the bulb.
- **Best planted in a mass of 30 or more for dramatic effect.**
- **Use:** Narcissus blooms are for many gardeners the first visible signs of spring. Deer Resistant. Good for the front of borders and small bouquets. Daffodils are the most cost effective, pest-free perennial plants available and make wonderful companions with other bulbs, perennials, annuals and flowering shrubs.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows to a height of 6-8" and 4" apart.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8. Perennial. Bulb.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Sturdy stems. Do not cut off the leaves after flowering. They will die back by summer end.
- **Flower:** The largest, pure white form of *N. bulbocodium* conspicuous with hoop petticoat-shaped, glistening white flowers, a star-shaped white perianth of narrow petals
