## Star of Bethlehem









Bright starry blooms cluster atop narrow leaves for a striking display of bold color and crisp form. Use solo as a centerpiece or arrange amongst a backdrop of foliage plants. Once flowering has ended, reduce watering to a minimum.

## Ornithogalum dubium

- <u>Use:</u> Beautiful and striking, this is the Star of Bethlehem! Of great ornamental value for its colorful flowers and easy to grow in pots or planters, patios, balconies, rockeries... wherever you want! A great potted plant for a sunny window or table centerpiece. Makes a nice gift plant! *Not for human or animal con*sumption.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full/part sun; Water occasionally, until established. Use slow release fertilizer. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Stems grow 6-8 inches high and taller(15-18") in bloom and 6-8" wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 7-10; Perennial.
- *Foliage:* Deciduous; Bluish-green leaves.
- **Flowers:** Up to 15-20 six-petaled florets form one large spherical flower at the top of a 12"-15" tall stem Attractive, long-lasting orange star-shaped flowers.
