

Tulip Apricot Beauty



- **Planting density:** 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- **Planting depth:** 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.
- **Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.**

Tulipa 'Apricot Beauty' Triumph type

- **Use:** Beds, rock gardens, in patio planters, and woodland gardens. For a show-stopping attraction in your garden, plant tulips in a group of 25 to 50. Plant with blue Hyacinths.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.
- **Growth:** Grows 14"+ tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8 Perennial Bulb
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long strap like leaves
- **Flower:** A fragrant, Single Early variety that's great for forcing, too. The outside of the blooms is soft salmon-rose overlaid on the edges with apricot; the inside is apricot with a star of light green at the base.
