Tulip Banja Luka



- Planting density: 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- Planting depth: 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.

Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.

Tulip 'Banja Luka' (Darwin hybrid)

- <u>Use:</u> One of the biggest tulips we've seen in years! and probably has one of the highest focal impacts with its bold contrast of rich blood red flames on bold golden bronze petals. Beds, rock gardens, in patio planters, and woodland gardens. Darwin Hybrids are the best perennial and the best tulip for cutting!
 - **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.
- **Growth:** Grows 22-24" tall. They are also one of the tallest with up to 6" diameter bloom when open.
- Hardiness: Zone 3-8 Perennial; Bulb
- Foliage: Deciduous. Long strap
 - Flower: Flaming yellow and red streaks adorned the petals of this show-stopping tulip. Unmatched in its huge perfect shaped blooms which float atop tall, sturdy stems. The two colors on this tulip make it wonderful for lovely bouquets and for pairing with other yellow, orange, and red bloomers. Represents perfect love & eternal happiness!
