

# Blushing Parrot Tulip



- **Planting density:** 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- **Planting depth:** 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.
- **Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.**



## *Tulipa 'Blushing Parrot'*

- **Use:** These parrot tulips have a fresh white-cream colour with a pink blush. Plant these beauties in large clusters for a showy display in late spring. With their exotic shape, color and design, parrot tulips resemble their namesake tropical birds. Parrot tulips are the largest and most spectacular of all tulips.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.
- **Growth:** Grows 16-20" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8 Perennial Bulb
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long strap like leaves.
- **Flower:** It opens pale yellow with feathered and scalloped purple-crimson petal edges and green feathering, and matures to white with magenta-rose edges. A flamboyant, late-blooming Tulip with large blooms, the Parrot Tulip is a decorator's delight both outdoors and indoors.
