## Eagle Wings Tulip



- Planting density: 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- Planting depth:

   6-8 inches to
   base of the bulb.

  Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.



## Tulipa 'Eagel Wings' (Parrot type)

- <u>Use:</u> Eagle Wings has charming feathery and frayed yellow petals which is typical for parakeet tulips. This is a fantastic and first-rate tulip that is very suitable as garden tulip, but is also very nice when it is picked for your vase.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil (sandy is great), but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall so they get as cold as possible in winter.
- *Growth:* Grows 16-18" tall.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 3-8 Perennial Bulb
- Foliage: Deciduous. Long strap-like leaves.
- **Flower:** Beautiful unique tulip predominately yellow with hints of green through the ruffled petal.
