

Eagle Wings Tulip



- **Planting density:** 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- **Planting depth:** 6-8 inches to base of the bulb. Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.

- **Use:** Eagle Wings has charming feathery and frayed yellow petals which is typical for parakeet tulips. This is a fantastic and first-rate tulip that is very suitable as garden tulip, but is also very nice when it is picked for your vase.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil (sandy is great), but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall so they get as cold as possible in winter.
- **Growth:** Grows 16-18" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8 Perennial Bulb
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long strap-like leaves.
- **Flower:** Beautiful unique tulip predominately yellow with hints of green through the ruffled petal.
