

Estella Rijnveld Tulip



- **Planting density:** 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- **Planting depth:** 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.
- **Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.**

Tulipa 'Estella Rijnveld'

- **Use:** The exotic Parrot Tulip begs to be the star of your garden with its showy, fringed and scalloped plumage and sensational striations. A flamboyant, late-blooming Tulip with large blooms, the Parrot Tulip is a decorator's delight both outdoors and indoors.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.
- **Growth:** Grows 16-22" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8 Perennial Bulb
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long strap like leaves.
- **Flower:** Circa 1954, this flamboyant bicolor heirloom is blazing red with prominent white flames that vary in width and intensity and occasional green flames. When it opens, it has a variable yellow cast that fades to bright white as the flowers mature.
