Estella Rijnveld Tulip



- Planting density: 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- Planting depth: 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.
- Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.

Tulipa 'Estella Rijnveld'

- <u>Use:</u> The exotic Parrot Tulip begs to be the star of your garden with its showy, fringed and scalloped plumage and sensational striations. A flamboyant, late-blooming Tulip with large blooms, the Parrot Tulip is a decorator's delight both outdoors and indoors.
 <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.
- *<u>Growth</u>:* Grows 16-22" tall.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 3-8 Perennial Bulb
- **Foliage**: Deciduous. Long strap like leaves.
- **<u>Flower</u>:** Circa 1954, this flamboyant bicolor heirloom is blazing red with prominent white flames that vary in width and intensity and occasional green flames. When it opens, it has a variable yellow cast that fades to bright white as the flowers mature.
