## Ms Zhang Tulip





- Planting density: 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- Planting depth: 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.
- Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.

## Tulipa 'Ms Zhang' Triumph type

• <u>Use:</u> One of the largest groups, Triumph Tulips are easy to grow and come in a wide range of colors. Plant in the fall and expect mid season blooms in the spring. They make perfect cutting flowers because of their long sturdy stems and beautiful traditional shaped tulip blossoms. For small spaces plant in containers or use as borders or added interest in any sun filled garden. For a showstopping attraction in your garden, plant tulips in a group of 25 to 50.

**Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. A layer of gritty paver sand will help with clay soils. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.

- *Growth:* Grows 14"+ tall.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 3-8 Perennial Bulb
- Foliage: Deciduous. Long strap like leaves
- **<u>Flower</u>**: A late blooming triumph type with a glowing orange flower. Good for forcing in pots as well.
