

Novi Sun Tulip



- **Planting density: 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.**
 - **Planting depth: 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.**
- Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.**

Tulipa 'Novi Sun' (Darwin type)

- **Use:** Like a burst of sunshine, Novi Sun radiates warmth, their large yellow cups flooded with light. Tall, sturdy stems ensure the blossoms withstand spring tempests. They also have the ability to come back and bloom reasonably well and are among best rated types for the South.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.
- **Growth:** Grows 22-24" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8 Perennial Bulb
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long strap-like leaves.
- **Flower:** Large, goblet-shaped blooms of brilliant sunshine-yellow in mid Spring. We love to use them indoors as cut flowers.
