

Outbreak Tulip



Tulipa 'Outbreak'

- **Planting density:** 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- **Planting depth:** 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.
- **Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.**
- **Use:** Triumph Tulip bulbs are the result of cross breeding Single Early Tulips and Darwin Hybrid Tulips. They are characterized by angular shaped flowers on medium high, sturdy stems.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.
- **Growth:** Grows 16-22" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8; Perennial; Bulb
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long strap like leaves.
- **Flower:** Bright yellow flowers and red edges. Flowers are supported by sturdy, grey-green stems that reach a medium-tall height and easily withstand the forces of wind and rain.
