

Purple Dream Tulip



Tulipa 'Purple Dream' (Lily type hybrid)

- **Use:** Probably one of the finest purple lily-flowered tulips, it features deep purple blossoms with pointed, reflexed petals and a delicate ivory heart! Blooming in the late spring garden, this tulip provides an elegant and graceful display when swaying in the spring breeze! They are also good companions with Daffodils and force well.
 - **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.
 - **Growth:** Grows 12-24" tall and 6" wide.
 - **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8 Perennial Bulb
 - **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long strap like leaves with unique mottling..
 - **Flower:** A dream, indeed. The clear, violet-purple blooms of this Lily-flowered Tulip look like a goblet as they reflex gracefully to pointed tips. Just a touch of white appears at the base of each flower and as occasional highlights on the interior. 'Impressive in a vase. Late.
- **Planting density: 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.**
 - **Planting depth: 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.**
 - **Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.**
