- Planting density: 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- Planting depth: 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.
- Best planted in a

mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.

• <u>Use:</u> This magnificent new variety is grape jelly-purple with lilac feathered white petal edges and strong stems. It flowers in mid spring and in a good companion to purple hyacinths. Also beautiful between red-leafed perennials like Heuchera. No spring garden should be without this beauty. Beds, rock gardens, in patio planters, and woodland gardens. For a show-stopping attraction in your garden, plant tulips in a group of 30 to 60.

**Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.

- *Growth:* Grows 18-20" tall.
- Hardiness: Zone 3-8 Perennial Bulb
- Foliage: Deciduous. Long strap
  - <u>Flower:</u> This magnificent new variety is grape jelly-purple with lilac feathered white petal edges and strong stems. Blooms midlate spring and great as a cut flower.
