

# Tulip Purple Flag



- **Planting density:** 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- **Planting depth:** 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.
- **Best planted in a mass of 30 or more for dramatic effect.**

## *Tulip 'Purple Flag' Triumph type*

- **Use:** Beds, rock gardens, in patio planters, and woodland gardens.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep them cool and remove again in the fall.
- **Growth:** Grows 18-20" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8. Perennial. Bulb.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Vibrant royal purple blooms on top of green foliage. Sure to be a showstopper in the garden. Triumph tulips are known for their beauty and elegance. It also makes a wonderful cut flower to help you enjoy your flowers indoors as well!
