Spring Song Tulip



- Planting density: 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- Planting depth: 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.
- Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.

Tulipa 'Spring Song' (Darwin hybrid)

• <u>Use:</u> This red beauty will be a showstopper in your garden. Darwin Hybrid tulips are a popular choice for the South because they are reliable, heat tolerant, and can grow in various conditions. No spring garden should be without this beauty. Beds, rock gardens, in patio planters, and woodland gardens. For a show-stopping attraction in your garden, plant tulips in a group of 30 to 60.

Exposure/Soil: Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.

- Growth: Grows 18-20" tall.
- Hardiness: Zone 3-8 Perennial Bulb
- Foliage: Deciduous. Long strap
- <u>Flower:</u> Large flowers of bright red, flushed salmon. Blooms mid-spring and great as a cut flower.
