

Tulip Sunny Prince



- **Planting density:** 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- **Planting depth:** 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.

Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.



Tulipa 'Sunny Prince' (Single Early type)

- **Use:** This cheerful Purple Prince sibling is pale lemon-yellow with a darker lemon interior . Pair this type with the candy prince for a stunning show!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.
- **Growth:** Grows 16-18" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8 Perennial Bulb
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long strap-like leaves.
- **Flower:** Lemon yellow splashed with a fluffy white meringue on the outer petals.
