Synaeda Amor Tulip



- Planting density: 4-6 inch apart, 5 per sq. ft.
- Planting depth: 6-8 inches to base of the bulb.
- Best planted in a mass of 20 or more for dramatic effect.



Tulipa 'Synaeda Amor'

- <u>Use:</u> Triumph Tulip bulbs are the result of cross breeding Single Early Tulips and Darwin Hybrid Tulips. They are characterized by angular shaped flowers on medium high, sturdy stems. This tulip is a great choice for forcing in pots also. Looks beautiful with hyacinths and daffodils.
 <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Place a layer of mulch over the bulbs in summer to keep cool and remove again in the fall.
- <u>Growth</u>: Grows 16-22" tall.
- Hardiness: Zone 3-8; Perennial; Bulb
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. Long strap like leaves.
- *Flower:* Produces big, rose pink flowers on sturdy stems.
