

Candy Onion



Candy' is big and sweet, an unusual pair of traits for a hybrid Onion. The bulbs measure up to 5in across and have smooth, golden skins. A good choice for French Onion soup, as the high sugar content glazes to a beautiful maple-syrup color. 'Candy' is a "day neutral" variety, which means it will grow almost anywhere in the country regardless of daylength. It also matures early, about 75 days from transplant. Proper curing ensures a good three months of storage.



Allium 'Candy'

- **Use:** Extra sweet and so mild, cutting Candy leaves you less teary-eyed. Flat globes 3-4" with tight, light yellow skin. Well adapted from northern Texas to the Maine, it's a day neutral variety.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Tolerates full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower 12" tall x 4".
- **Hardiness:** 4-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen.
- **Flower:** Small pom pom purple flowers in summer.
