

White One Ornamental Onion



Allium schoenoprasum 'White One'

- **Use:** A new series of highly ornamental and edible chives. Chives grow in clumps, with their round, hollow, grass-like leaves reaching a height of 12 inches or so. The stems are firm, straight, smooth, and, like the leaves, bright dark green. The flowers, which bloom for two months in midsummer, form round deep white globes that make an attractive garnish.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Tolerates full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower 12" tall x 12" wide clumping.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen.
- **Flower:** Small pom pom white flowers in summer.
