

# Bull's Blood Beets



## *Beta vulgaris* 'Bull's Blood'

- **Use:** 50 days. This beautiful beet has deep reddish-purple leaves! Very sweet and delicious, the baby leaves are a rage in salads. The beets are tasty too, and have pretty pink rings inside.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows 21-26" tall.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9; annual, winter hardy
- **Foliage:** HEIRLOOM Grown primarily for striking dark red-purple leaves that provide incredible contrast in salad mixes. Eliot Coleman's choice for a red leaf in winter salad mixes. Roots are also tasty and tender when harvested early as baby beets. Tolerant to heat and cold. Color intensifies as plants mature
- **Flowers:** Not known for flowers.
