

# Early Wonder Beets



Beets will no doubt add color to any dish. It can be found in soup, sautéed and salads.

## *Beta vulgaris 'Early Wonder' (50 days from sow to harvest)*

- **Use:** Since 1911, 'Early Wonder' has delivered abundant greens, flavorful beets, and early production. Great for mild climates where multiple crops are possible. The 18" greens are as delicious, and high in vitamins A and C, iron, and potassium. Quick-growing tops perfect for early beet greens, while roots size up quickly for bunched baby beets. Also a great full size beet with vibrant tops.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows 12" tall and 6" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; annual, winter hardy
- **Foliage/ Root:** Leaf tops are dark green on red stems. Ideal for fresh eating, roasting, or pickling. Leaves may be sautéed as well.
- **Flowers:** Not known for flowers.
