

Red Cloud Beets



It is very resistant to bolting and a single planting can be harvested over a long season.



Beta vulgaris 'Red Cloud'

- **Use:** 50 days. This beautiful beet has deep reddish-purple leaves! Very sweet and delicious, the baby leaves are a rage in salads. The beets are tasty too, and have pretty pink rings inside.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows 21-26" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; annual, winter hardy
- **Foliage:** One of the sweetest, highest quality beets. High sugar content, superior top strength, smooth shape and intense red color with no zoning make this beet exceptional for dicing, slicing and whole baby beets. Has long holding ability
- **Flowers:** Not known for flowers.
- **Harvest:** Begin picking at 1" for baby beets and up to 3" across for the most tender and best tasting. For best storage cut off the greens 2" above the top of the beet.
