Brassica 'Copenhagen' Market Early

- **Use:** Produces early, 2 to 3 pound Cabbage heads. It's excellent for the table and sauerkraut. It is very flavorful and tender. Heads rarely burst. Introduced by H. Hartman & Company in 1909. Medium size cabbage is perfect for smaller home gardens. Crop time 66 days.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. They must have well-drained soils, so if you have red clay you must amend it. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Grows 12" tall and 12" wide. Recommended spacing is 12 to 15 inches on rows at least three feet apart. You can also increase production in small garden by planting a double row on a bed.
- **Hardiness:** Vegetable; Can be planted in spring, fall, or winter.
- **Foliage:** These compact heads are sweet for fabulous coleslaw, salad, or sauerkraut. Copenhagen Market became the standard of excellence for many store-bought varieties that were developed after it! Adaptable to a range of climates. Resists splitting and stores well.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers. To prevent bolting protect Cabbage from temperatures below 40 degrees with a frost cloth.
