- <u>Use:</u> Miz America is a strikingly beautiful red mizuna mustard hybrid with exceptionally uniform leaf color, shape and size. Miz America was bred to produce highquality baby greens and still maintain its deep, dark red color on both sides of the leaf, even at a mature stage. Plant them behind your pansies for a striking backdrop that is edible too!
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Plant in full sun. Prefers moist, rich soils with good drainage.
- <u>Growth</u>: Grows 4-10" tall and 4-8" wide.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 4-8; Annual; Lasts all winter and spring.
- *Foliage:* Evergreen in our mild winters. Adds a colorful pizzazz to salads and offers something new and different for the market. Vigorous and cold resistant.
- *Flower:* Tall stalks of sulfur yellow flowers in spring.
