Brassica oleracea 'China King'

- **Use:** China King miniature (baby) Chinese cabbage is a natural for the grill—just halve and brush with oil. The 6-inch heads each make 2 servings, perfect for smaller families or a fancy-looking but super-easy side dish. The compact plants are suitable for close spacing, are bolt tolerant, and resistant to tipburn.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. They must have well-drained soils, so if you have red clay you must amend it. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Grows 8-18" tall and 6" wide. Space plants about 10 inches apart in rows that are 18 to 30 inches apart, as it's a compact, baby-type variety suitable for close spacing.
- **Hardiness:** Vegetable; Can be planted in spring, summer, or fall, .
- **Foliage:** The barrel-shaped heads are bright green and white on the outside with a pale yellow interior color. Expect maturity about 55 days from transplant. 2 lbs
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
