
Coral Queen Ornamental Kale

Brassica oleracea 'Coral Queen'

- <u>Use:</u> Looks great planted against pansies and parsley!
 Prefers cool weather and thrives all winter in the garden.
 The center leaves turn brilliant colors in late October as the weather cools. Veining in center leaves indicates color it will turn into later.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun. Prefers moist, but not wet soils. If you don't have good drainage they will rot.
- *Growth:* Grows 8-12" tall and 10-18" wide.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 7a-11b; Annual; Lasts all winter.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Evergreen in winter; Deeply notched, feathery foliage surrounded by a large head held by a strong stem. Foliage edges are purple-green with a brightly colored reddish-purple center.
- **Flower:** Tall stalks of sulfur yellow flowers in spring.
