

Brussel Sprouts



Brassica oleracea 'Jade Cross'

- **Use:** The plants are more compact than other varieties, which makes them less subject to wind damage. Early maturity allows for later planting when cooler growing conditions are more favorable. Very adaptable.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. They must have well-drained soils, so if you have red clay you must amend it. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Plants reach 28 inches tall. About 55 days from transplant.
- **Hardiness:** Vegetable; Can be planted in spring or fall.
- **Foliage:** looks similar to a cabbage on top
- **Flower:** Produces high yields of deep green .75" - 1" Brussels sprouts
