

# Curly Cabbage



## *Brassica oleracea 'Nagoya' series*

- **Use:** Looks great planted against pansies and parsley! Prefers cool weather and thrives all winter in the garden. The center leaves turn brilliant colors in late October as the weather cools. Veining in center leaves indicates color it will turn into later.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun. Prefers moist, but not wet soils.
- **Growth:** Grows 1' tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Curly leaves! You could eat it, but probably a bitter flavor they were bred for color not flavor.
- **Flower:** Tall stalks of sulfur yellow flowers in spring.
