

Ornamental Cabbage/ Kale



Brassica oleracea 'Osaka' series

- **Use:** Looks great planted against pansies and parsley! Prefers cool weather and thrives all winter in the garden. The center leaves turn brilliant colors in late October as the weather cools. Veining in center leaves indicates color it will turn into later.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun. Prefers moist, but not wet soils. If you don't have good drainage they will rot.
- **Growth:** Grows 1' tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Annual; Lasts all winter.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen in winter; Curly leaves! You could eat it, but probably a bitter flavor as they were bred for color not flavor. Color deepens with the first frosts and cooler nights.
- **Flower:** Tall stalks of sulfur yellow flowers in spring.
