

# Peacock Ornamental Cabbage



## *Brassica oleracea 'Peacock' series*

- **Use:** Looks great planted against pansies and parsley! Prefers cool weather and thrives all winter in the garden. Try a spray of beautiful foliage! Peacock Red is shades of rose and green to compliment many colors in your Fall beds and containers. Ornamental kale, also called borecole, is a great addition to your fall décor. Works well in wet conditions as the open, feathery leaves are less likely to trap and hold water than fringe- and round-leaf types.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun. Prefers moist, but not wet soils.
- **Growth:** Grows 1' tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Annual; Lasts winter to spring.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; It is a bold, round plant that exhibits great color during the Fall months. Just as with ornamental cabbage, kale isn't very tasty or tender, so chowing down on it is not advised! This fancy leaved plant comes in red and white, and it's great color makes it perfect for an ornamental. You should see color after the first frost, then watch them really amaze you with their changing colors.
- **Flower:** Tall stalks of sulfur yellow flowers in spring.
