

Edible Red Bor Kale



Brassica oleracea 'Redbor'

- **Use:** Wow, a completely magenta kale! Mild and crisp, this finely curled kale adds a colorful pizzazz to salads. Vigorous and cold resistant. Prefers cool weather and thrives all winter in the garden. The center leaves turn brilliant colors in late October as the weather cools. Veining in center leaves indicates color it will turn into later.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun. Prefers moist, but not wet soils.
- **Growth:** Grows 18-24" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Annual; Lasts all winter.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; finely-curved, deep red leaves are sweet and tender. This plant grows well in spring as well as in fall.
- **Flower:** Tall stalks of sulfur yellow flowers in spring.

Looks beautiful planted with pansies, parsley, snapdragons, and dusty miller in the winter garden.
