

Top Bunch Collards



Brassica oleracea 'Top Bunch'

- **Use:** Top Bunch hybrid is heavy yielding, early maturing, and more uniform than traditional varieties. Relatively slow to bolt. Grows best in full sun, but will tolerate partial shade and even appreciates it in spring in hot climates. Highly nutritious. Like all collards, the leaves are rich in vitamins and sweetened by frost. Young leaves are the most tender.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun. Prefers moist, rich soils with good drainage.
- **Growth:** Grows 18-24" tall. Space transplants 36 inches apart in rows 36 inches apart.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Annual; Lasts all winter.
- **Foliage:** The leaves are upright, broad, and a beautiful, waxy, deep green.
- **Flower:** Tall productive plant produces medium green, slightly blistered (savoyed) leaves.

This hybrid collard provides generous yields, thanks in part to leaves that grow back very quickly after hand picking. Grown using organic practices.
