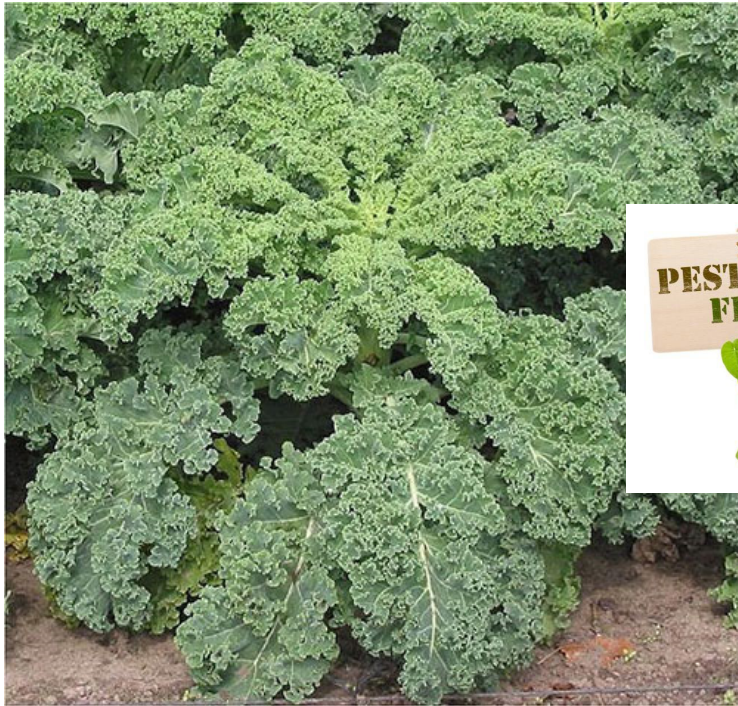


Dwarf Blue Curled Kale

Brassica oleracea 'Vates'

- **Use:** One of the most attractive of all vegetables in the fall garden. Low, compact plants with finely curled, bluish-green leaves. Usually stands winter weather with some protection. Good cooked or fresh in salads. Grows best in cool weather. Can be grown as a spring or fall crop.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun. Prefers moist, rich soils with good drainage.
- **Growth:** Grows 12" tall and 12-16" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Annual; Lasts all winter and spring.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen in our mild winters. Freezing weather enhances sweetness. Finely curled, vigorous leaves with lush, blue-green color.
- **Flower:** Tall stalks of sulfur yellow flowers in spring.
