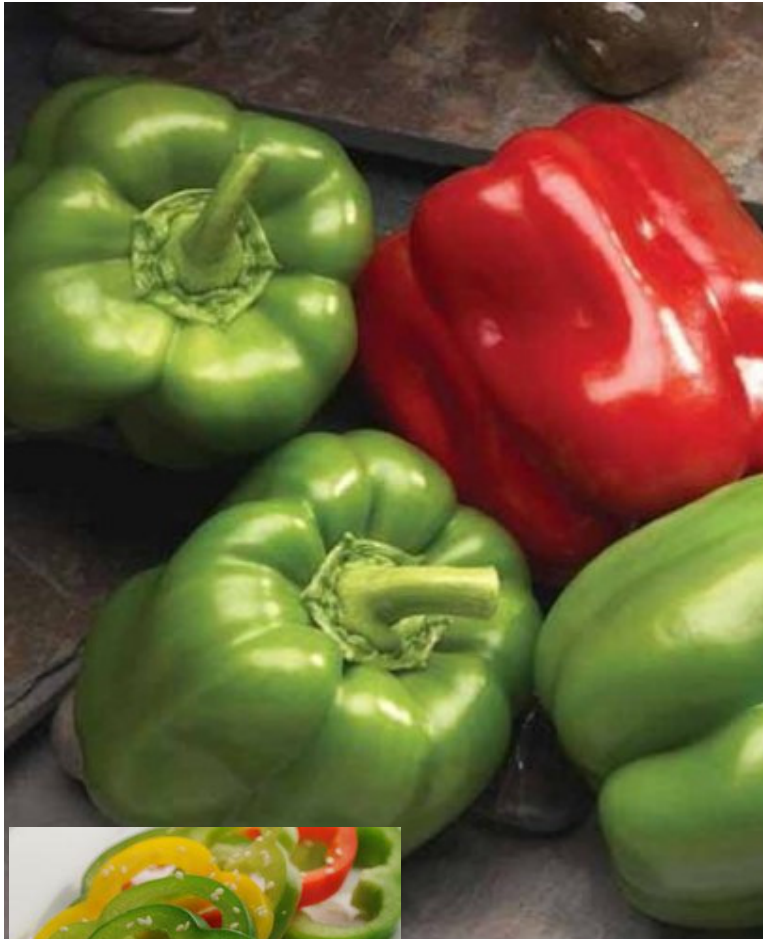


Better Belle Pepper



Early, tasty variety. Blocky, thick-walled, four-lobed. Plant maintains large fruit size and production all season. Tobacco Mosaic tolerant. Green to red fruit 4.6 x 3.5 in. fruit. 65 days to maturity.

- **Use:** You can also grow sweet peppers in containers. Only plant peppers outdoors on a cloudy day, just prior to getting rain. Plant when soil is warm, at least 2 weeks after last frost, and when temperatures remain above 70 F.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Plants can grow 3 to 4 ft tall.
- **Hardiness:** 9-11, annual, houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Small leaves.
- **Flower:** These peppers are vigorous, fast growers perfect for patio pots. Better Belles are ready to harvest earlier than other varieties, producing tasty, thick-walled fruit as big as 5 in. (13 cm) across. The fruit matures from green to deep orange, making an attractive addition to salads and veggie trays.
